Eligibility:	Teams can be mixed; boys & girls, years 5 & 6.
	Minimum 4 players; maximum 6 players per team.
	Each school may enter a maximum of two teams. This is limited due to court availability.
	If you wish to enter more than two teams, please fill in the third team list. There is a
	possibility that this may be possible but can only be confirmed once all entries have been
	received. Please enter your teams in section 1 or 2. If you have any North Harbour Junior
	Representative players in your team, that team must be in section 1. Badminton North
	Harbour has the right to re-grade teams if they think they are in the wrong grade.
Format:	Each tie consists of 4 singles and 2 doubles matches (6 matches in total).
	Each match is played based on time, the winning player/pair shall be the one/s with the
	highest score when time is stopped.
	The team that wins the most matches wins the tie based on the BWF scoring system for round
	robin play.

Prizes:Certificates will be issued for all players. All members of the winning team from each section will receive individual medals.
